## **RE: Piano lessons at Haddenham Junior School**

Your child has the opportunity to learn piano at school. They will have the opportunity to play for ABRSM exams, or simply for enjoyment. It is recommended that your child is able to practice at home on a piano, or an electric keyboard in the early stages if you don't own a piano. Exams will be undertaken only when we are confident it will be a positive experience, and all parties are keen. You will be required to purchase music occasionally- for complete beginners, please purchase a copy of *Me and My Piano book 1*, and *Music Theory for Young Musicians- Grade 1*, both available at Aylesbury Music on Temple Street. You should try to come to your first lesson with these, if possible.

It's important to practice regularly, and homework is set every week. The homework is always achievable with relatively little work, but just enough to ensure that you are playing regularly. With a bit of effort, piano playing can become a deeply rewarding hobby and an asset to every CV, and with a bit more work it can become a lifestyle! Students are welcome to study classical piano, pop or jazz and blues- so long as they throw themselves into it. I am, of course, happy to teach a style according to the student's enthusiasm, and with the understanding of the parents.

There will be 33 lessons- roughly one a week- over the course of the year, at a cost of £396. This is payable by 3 cheques, dated 1<sup>st</sup> September 2020, 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021, and 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021 each for £132. This will equate to 11 lessons each term, though this may vary slightly, however total for year will not. Lessons usually operate on a rolling timetable to avoid missing the same classes each week. Timetables are issued at the beginning of term, for your on-going reference. Please bring your book every lesson- this is very important. You will also be given a little book to note homework in, and for any parent-teacher communications. There will also be occasional opportunities to play at concerts, should you wish!

Regarding COVID 19 and September 2020 start: due to timetable changes within HCJS there are a finite number of slots available for start in September 2020. Continuing students will be prioritised and should all get places. Students entering year 3 are encouraged to complete and return their form and cheques as soon as possible in order that you may secure one of the remaining slots. It appears likely that some students will have to be turned away, and in this scenario, I will consider other options depending on how long the list is, such as group lessons. Some lessons may continue via Skype if this is deemed necessary. In the event of another school closure, all lessons will continue via Skype.
